We are working on a plan to open up for visitation. As soon as this plan has been approved by DHEC we will reach out to you and provide you with information.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. The testing rate follows our county, Spartanburg, rate of positive cases. If our county moves into a lower bracket based on positive cases, we will be able to move to a lesser amount for testing negative employees.

Governor McMaster has instructed all South Carolina nursing homes to ease back into a visitation schedule. We are waiting for confirmation from the state regarding our visitation policy. Once we have approval, we will be contacting families with the process for visits. We appreciate your patience throughout this process.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. 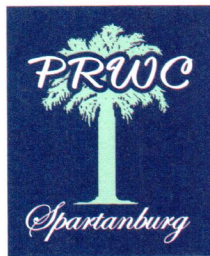
